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INTRODUCTION

In today's world, we are all busy and stretched in a thousand directions but inherently we want to help others. Fortunately, there is a new trend in philanthropy and it's called a giving circle. A giving circle is formed when individuals come together and pool their dollars, decide together where to give the money and learn collaboratively about their community's needs. This is the philanthropic model of 100 Who Care.

ABOUT 100 WHO CARE

100 Who Care started in 2006 by Karen Dunigan in Jackson, Michigan. Driven by her desire to make a difference in her community, Karen designed a giving circle whereby 100+ women met for 1 hour, 4 times per year (quarterly). The women learned about three local charities at each giving circle event and voted on which nonprofit to support that quarter. Each woman wrote a \$100 check to the selected organization and in ONE hour, \$10,000+ was raised for that charity. Karen's simple concept has grown into 600+ Chapters (women, men, teens/kids, people and businesses) around the world; there are another 250 Chapters in development. In the past 12 years, millions of dollars have been donated to charities. *Annually*, 100 Who Care Chapters create a potential impact of \$22M in donations.

In Arizona, there are nine Chapters actively donating to charities in their local communities – Flagstaff, Prescott, Tucson, Sierra Vista, Phoenix, Ahwatukee, Scottsdale, East Valley and West Valley. Collectively, 1,000+ women come together each quarter. *In the past four years, they have donated over* \$750,000.

LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

The 100 Who Care Alliance is a small group of leaders who volunteer their time to promote advocacy and provide resources for 100 Who Care chapters worldwide. Every two years, a leadership conference is held for chapter leaders from around the world to come together and share best practices and discuss the growth and promotion of 100 Who Care organizations. The Alliance's goal is to provide support to chapters so they can make an even bigger, charitable impact to nonprofits in their local communities.

CONFERENCE ATTENDEES

Women and men, primarily from the US and Canada, who voluntarily give of their time and resources to run their Chapters, will be in attendance. These individuals are go-getters, professionals, entrepreneurs, nurturers, caregivers and difference makers. They come from a variety of backgrounds and have one thing in common...they CARE about their local communities.

100 Who Care Chapters are non-revenue generating organizations. 100% of charitable donations made by Chapter members at their quarterly giving circles are directed to the nonprofits they select. The cost to attend this conference comes from the personal resources of the Chapter leaders. Through corporate partnerships, our goal is to reduce the 2019 conference registration fee and make it feasible for over 200 Chapter leaders to attend the conference. The more chapter leaders we can reach, the greater the impact our attendees will have in their communities around the world.
